INTRODUCING ARGONNE NATIONAL LABORATORY'S PACKAGING UNIVERSITY SUMMER INSTITUTE

In the summer of 2025, Argonne is launching a Packaging University Summer Institute, sponsored by the U.S. Department of Energy Office of Environmental Management (DOE-EM) Packaging Certification Program (PCP).

The Summer Institute enhances
Argonne's support of the DOE-EM
Packaging University Program (PUP).
The Institute also supports the mission
of DOE-EM's Office of Packaging
and Transportation to bridge the
knowledge and experience gap
between longtime experts in nuclear
packaging and college and university
students, as well as early- and
mid-career professionals looking
for opportunities to enter the field.

The Institute is important because it helps nuclear industry and regulators:

- □ Identify, recruit, train, retain, and advance motivated employees
- ☐ Gain credibility with clients

Longer term, the Institute will also engage high school and junior high school students in the STEM field of nuclear packaging.

WHAT IS THE HISTORY OF PACKAGING UNIVERSITY?

Since 1997, DOE-EM has supported Argonne and other national laboratories offering 3–10-day courses on transportation packaging for nuclear and other radioactive material. In 2013, DOE-EM, Argonne, and the University of Nevada, Reno began collaboration to develop graduate certificates programs in nuclear packaging (GCNP) and in transport security and safeguards (GCTSS). Since 2015, Argonne has held graduate-level training courses as part of the PUP, including hands-on experience with its ARG-US remote sensing and monitoring technologies.

HOW WILL THE SUMMER INSTITUTE HELP ME?

The pioneering Summer Institute will:

- Help you gain broader and greater in-depth knowledge on packaging for nuclear and other radioactive material—emphasizing transportation Safety, Security, and Safeguards (3S).
- Enable you to acquire skills, make contacts in the field, and earn a university credential.
- Make you more competitive for employment and advancement.



HOW WILL IT WORK?

Beginning 2025, the annual Summer Institute will more efficiently leverage teaching and other key resources to help students master course learning objectives by combining transport security and transport emergency courses this summer and the ASME Code and packaging quality assurance courses in 2026.

All courses are taught by highly experienced subject matter experts.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

The Summer Institute is open to both professionals in the field and highly qualified graduate university students who are recommended by their advisors. Limited housing at Argonne's Guest House will be available, and university students may qualify for financial support.
