Power

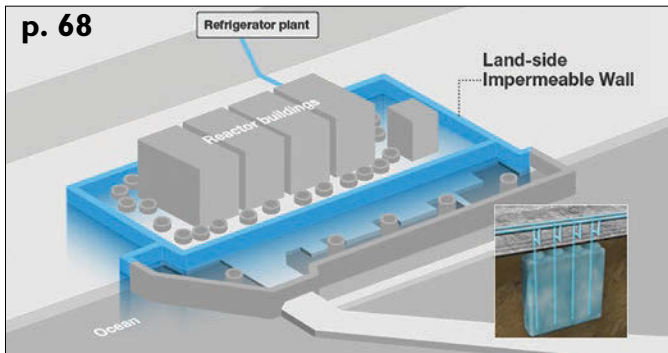
22 NRC authorizes combined operating licenses for South Texas-3 and -4. Extended power uprate put into effect at Peach Bottom-3. NRC staff seeks changes to enforcement policy. Wolf Creek issued violation notice for medical reporting issues. Focus on Finance. Miami's appeal on new Turkey Point reactors denied by NRC. Maximizing the Assets: A status report on license renewal and power uprates. Six more reactors said to comply with NRC orders on mitigation strategies and spent fuel pool instrumentation. Commissioners approve NRC staff's plan for closure of post-Fukushima Tier 2 and 3 issues. Braidwood licenses renewed; other renewal developments.

29 NNSA awards academic consortium \$25-million grant for nuclear science and security R&D; other NNSA news. DOE states preference for disposal of surplus non-pit plutonium at WIPP. Domsday Clock remains at three minutes to midnight. Ex-NRC scientist pleads guilty to cyber crime.

33 Nuclear R&D measure added to Senate energy bill. NRC adopts plan for commissioners to have early input on rulemaking process.



International 68

Soil-freezing system installed at Fukushima Daiichi. Takahama-3 is third reactor to resume operation in Japan. IAEA mission notes regulatory progress in Japan. Life extension to 60 years to be studied for Bulgaria's Kozloduy-6. India joins Convention on Supplementary Compensation, opening nuclear market to U.S. vendors. Shin-Kori-3 sends first power to South Korean grid. Saudi Arabia, China agree to cooperate on gas-cooled reactor development. Excavation work begun at Hanhikivi-1 site in Finland. South Korean utility to support CANDU work in Argentina.
